Nomination Requirements:

- Must be a DIA active member or associate member in good standing (must have been a member the previous calendar year). Current DIA Board members are ineligible.
- May be nominated by a DIA member, supervisor or defense attorney.
- The nominating party must submit the nomination and two supporting letters of recommendation from persons familiar with the nominee's work.
- The nomination and supporting letters should describe how the nominee has performed his/her duties in defense of the indigent accused in an exemplary manner and in accordance with the ideals of the DIA; i.e. professionalism, diligence, resourcefulness and integrity.
- The nomination and supporting letters should be submitted to the Investigator of the Year Award Committee by **August 19th, 2022.**
